



## EN Instructions

### Product Information

The wallpapers are made of high-quality materials that ensure durability, aesthetics, and resistance to external factors. Printed using modern technologies, they offer intense colors, precise details, and resistance to fading. The product is designed to fit various interiors, both residential and commercial.

### Preparation Before Installation

Make sure the product has no visible damage. Choose a dry, clean, and even wall. Use a level and a pencil to mark vertical installation lines. Prepare the adhesive according to the manufacturer's instructions by dissolving it in the correct proportions.

### Step-by-Step Instructions

**1.** Apply a thin layer of adhesive only to the area where the wallpaper will be applied. Avoid covering the entire wall at once to prevent the adhesive from drying too quickly. **2.** Apply the wallpaper from the top, aligning it with the marked lines. Place the strips edge to edge without overlapping. Installation with two people will help avoid creases. **3.** After application, smooth the wallpaper with a rubber roller to remove air bubbles. Avoid shifting the wallpaper to prevent damage. **4.** Remove excess adhesive with a damp cloth, being careful not to press too hard. **5.** Allow the wallpaper to dry for 24 hours at a temperature of 20°C. Close windows and doors to avoid drafts. **6.** Once dry, trim excess wallpaper with a sharp knife. Do not trim when the wallpaper is still wet.

### Cleaning and Maintenance

The wallpaper should be cleaned with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use aggressive detergents or abrasive materials that could damage the surface. Dust can be removed with a dry cloth or a vacuum cleaner with a soft brush attachment.
